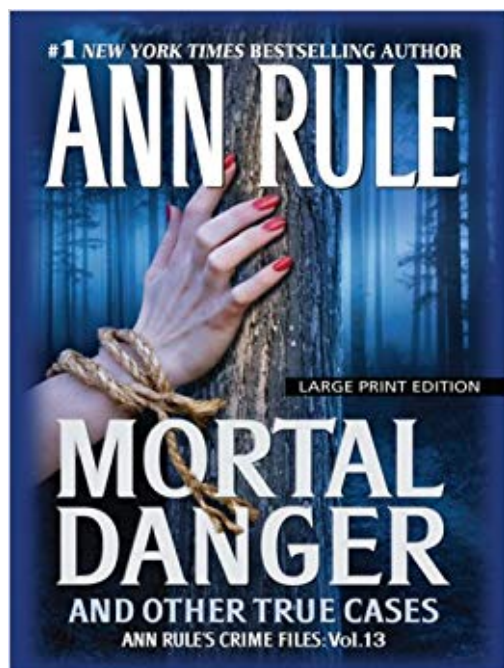

I especially appreciate the research that she does to give us a glimpse into the perpetrator's life and laus before us the likely circumstances which led him/her too commit the crime.
