

The library copy I read before my purchase had the word crossed out in ink by a Mrs. Grundy trying to "protect" our children. Another reviewer who gave the book 5 stars nonetheless felt obliged to point out its inclusion. Out of curiosity I did a word search for American Kennel Club and bitch and found 948,000 references relating to breeding, care, application forms and the like. Grow up folks! Oh, yes, and buy the book. You'll love it.
