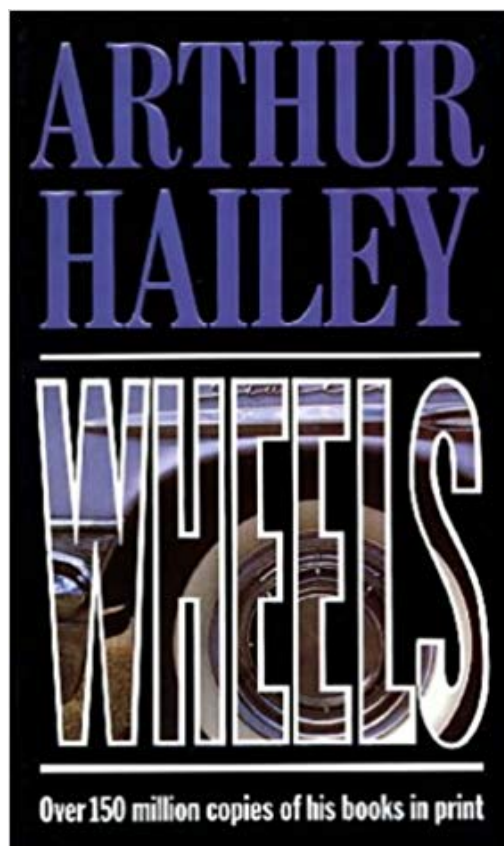

There was no backside title page in the Kindle edition (where one usually finds the year first published) but I believe from what I remember when I first read it at age 16 that it was published in the early 1970's.
